This scholarship application is for graduated/graduating high school seniors who are sponsored by a current and active dues paying member(s) in good standing for a minimum of two years with the Coalition of Black Trade Unionist (CBTU) Detroit Chapter. Two (2) recipients will be awarded \$500 each.

Selection process will be based on Grade Point Average (G.P.A.); extra-curricular activities, community-related activities, financial needs and a 300–400-word essay.

Recipients must be admitted to an accredited community college or a four-year college/university, prior to receiving scholarship funds.

Scholarship Criteria

Submit an official an official high school transcript and a current wallet size photograph. Affix your name, phone number, email address and home address to the back of the photograph.

Submit an acceptance letter from an accredited community college a four-year college/university or accredited trade school for the fall 2022 academic year.

The CBTU Sponsor must be related to applicant via blood, marriage, or adoption. The CBTU Sponsor must be current financially and an active participating member (minimum two years) of the Detroit Chapter.

The Application Form

Complete all questions on the application (please type or print clearly). Use "N/A" if a question is not applicable; do not leave a blank space. The application must be signed to be accepted. Attach your most recent high school transcript and the letter of acceptance from the community college, four-year college, or trade school you will be attending in the fall.

A completed CBTU Sponsor Verification Form must accompany the application.

All parts of your application including references must be postmarked by midnight June 15, 2022.
